

Hello Families

We are excited for the start of SUMMER CAMP Below you will find specific information for our drop off and pick up procedure. You will also find reminders of what to bring (and not bring) to camp!!

Please note: campers SHOULD be able to change themselves in/out of bathing suits and clothes. Our staff cannot help campers change

Campers will be broken up by age. On the first day, your camper should report to the following color group (based on the grade they will enter in the fall).

PINK: PRE K

RED: KINDERGARTEN

ORANGE: FIRST

YELLOW: SECOND

LIGHT GREEN: THIRD

GREEN: FOURTH

LIGHT BLUE: FIFTH

DARK BLUE: SIXTH

PURPLE: SEVENTH / EIGHTH

GRAY: TEEN

With everyone's safety in mind, a specific drop-off and pick-up route has been implemented. Please be sure to follow this route and adhere to all signage.

ARRIVAL (8:45 am – 9:00 am) SEE MAP ATTACHED

All parents will drive directly into the circle in front of the Lathrop Building.

Cars will be stopped so that campers can safely exit the vehicles.

Campers will exit their vehicles and check in at the attendance table.

Campers will walk to their designated group.

PICK-UP (3:45 – 4:00 pm) SEE MAP ATTACHED

PARENTS WILL REMAIN IN THEIR CARS! When you enter the park, proceed straight towards the pavilion in the back of the park. You will drive by the waterfront and line up by the snack bar.

WHEN CAMPERS ARE ALL IN FRONT OF THE LATHROP BUILDING: we will open the gate and begin camper pick up. YOU HAVE AN ONLINE PICK UP CARD ON YOUR HOUSEHOLD ACCOUNT!!

Show the card to our staff, proceed to the front circle and your child will be waiting with the counselor to hop into your vehicle.

PARENTS WITH CAR SEATS ... please proceed slowly to the parking lot to strap you little ones in their seats so it does not hold up the line.

IF YOU WALK TO CAMP TO PICK UP YOUR CAMPER have your camper pick up card ready. A staff member will meet you at the crosswalk/corner and get your camper for you.

845-554-9361) is always best to coordinate a good time to chat. Often pick up and drop off times are too chaotic to have constructive conversations. If a director needs to chat with you, they will call to make arrangements for a good time to chat.

What to Bring to Camp:

- Mark all personal belongings with name.
- Bathing suit, sneakers (mandatory), sandals (optional).
- Towel, sunscreen & water (bottles that can be refilled).
- Lunch appropriate for summer camp.
- Lunches cannot be refrigerated or heated at camp.

What NOT to Bring to Camp:

- We adhere to a strict policy of no electronics or use of personal cell phones while at camp (only exception may be if your child's group is doing a special activity with advance notification)...We will be device free this summer, **LEAVE ALL ELECTRONICS AT HOME**
- Your child **MUST** communicate with parents through the proper channel at camp (a camp director or counselor), not through a personal device. Please call the Recreation Office to communicate messages to or about your child.
- Toys or personal belongings from home (unless otherwise directed from camp for a specific activity).
- Camp is not responsible for the loss of any personal or valuable belongings.

CAMP NIGHT AT THE CARNIVAL - Each year, we coordinate with the Pawling Fire Department to have **CAMP NIGHT AT THE PAWLING FIRE DEPARTMENT CARNIVAL**. This year, **CAMPERS** will **TAKE OVER** on Thursday, August 14. Registration **IS** required and opens July 7. Campers receive a food voucher for a **FREE** meal. Hamburger, Cheeseburger, Hot Dog **OR** Chicken Nuggets, Fries and Water. Campers should wear their summer camp tee shirt
